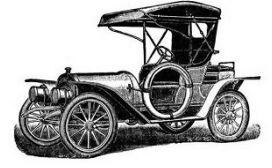

TELESCOPE

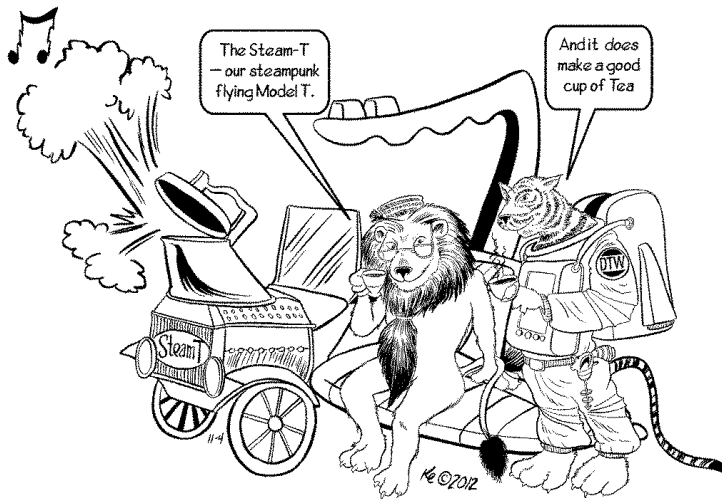
We are sorry that the Telescope viewing of Saturn on Thursday night was cancelled on short notice.
